Restaurants are also offering special deals this weekend for runners and their supporters in honor of the New York City Marathon on Sunday:

For Marathon Sunday, runners who show their bib receive 25 percent off their total check for the entire table at [Casa Nonna](#), 310 West 37th Street (between Eighth and Ninth Avenues), in Midtown, and [GO Burger](#), 1448 Second Avenue (between 75th and 76th Streets), on the Upper East Side. Runners will also be entered into a raffle to win gift certificates. The deal started Thursday and runs through Sunday.

Runners looking to carbo-load before the marathon can choose from an all-pasta menu on Saturday at [Abboccato Ristorante](#), 136 West 55th Street (between Sixth and Seventh Avenues), in Midtown. There will be 13 different pasta options, including gluten-free ones, available from noon to 11 p.m. Reservations: (212) 265-4000.
